I understand that as part of my assessment and/or on-going coordination of services that this organization maintains records that includes health information pertinent to my present and on-going issues. I understand that this information serves as a basis for recommendations that are made to improve or stabilize my safety and well being.

I have read and understand the Notice of Privacy Practices, which provides information about how Community Care Associates may use and disclose protected information about me. I acknowledge that I have a right to review CCA's notice of privacy before signing this consent. I also understand that CCA may change the context of the Privacy Notice and that I will be mailed a copy of the revised document with 30 days of revision.

I understand that I have a right to request that CCA restrict how protected information about me is used or disclosed for treatment, payment or health care activities. I understand that even if CCA does not agree with the restrictions I stipulate that CCA is bound to honor my restrictions. I understand that I can revoke this consent at any time I writing and also understand that any information disclosed prior to my revocation was allowed under the signed consent.
